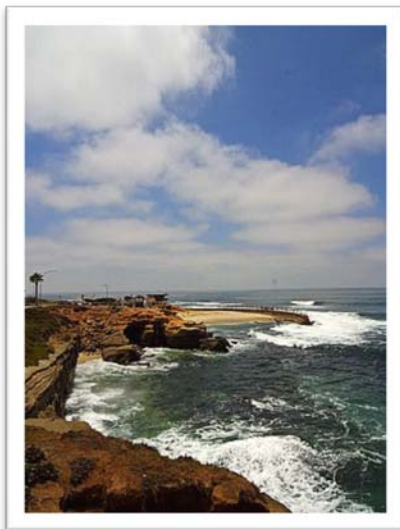
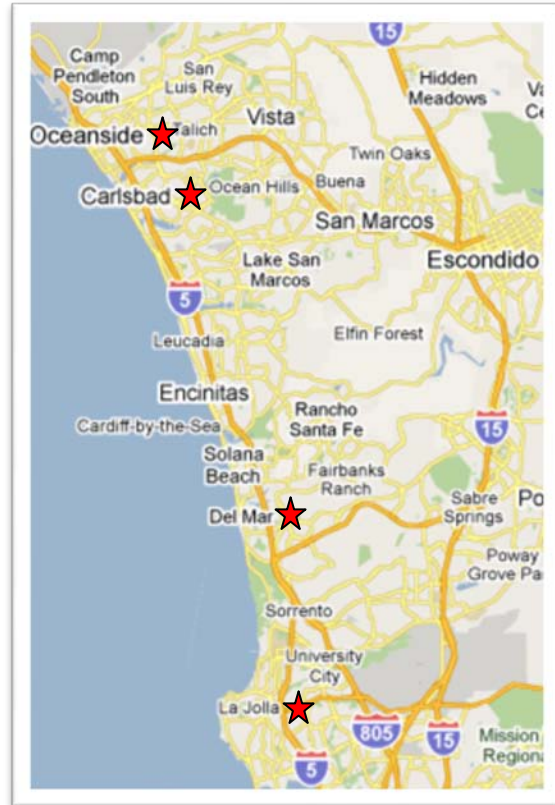

La Jolla: For the ultimate California experience, stroll along Coast Boulevard or Prospect Street and watch the pelicans patrol the waves, have lunch overlooking the water or shop at local boutiques. You'll likely see a family of seals lounging on the shore at Children's Pool Beach. The green expanse of Scripp's Park draws adults and children, who delight in the beauty of La Jolla Cove against the backdrop of the shimmering blue Pacific.

Del Mar: The City of Del Mar, world famous for its horseracing (July – September at the fairgrounds), has one of North County's most popular beaches. Located just north of Torrey Pines State Beach, Del Mar's beach is perfect for families, tourists, and surfers who enjoy its wide expanse of sand.

Carlsbad: Here you'll find Batiquitos Lagoon with its 600 acres of restored wetlands, visitor's center, and hiking trail running north. Farther south near the community of Leucadia is Ponto Beach, known for

its high sand dunes. One of the most scenic drives in San Diego County lies along the Carlsbad coastline

Oceanside: Oceanside, which is 35 miles north of downtown San Diego, is the northern gateway to San Diego County. It has excellent hotels, a picturesque harbor, miles of beautiful sandy beaches and a multitude of shopping alternatives. It also neighbors Camp Pendleton, the major West Coast base of the US Marine Corps.
